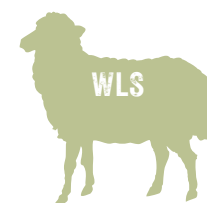
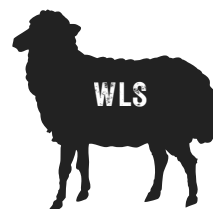
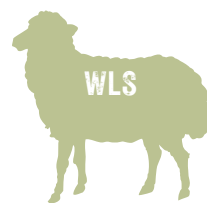
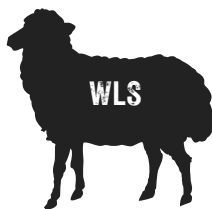
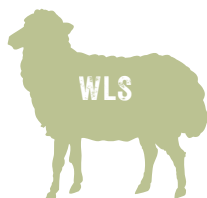
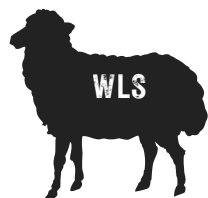
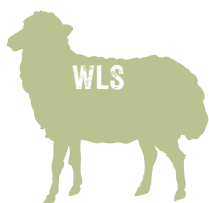
Another increase in numbers of prime lambs forward on the week with a total of 4,349 forward with trade on par with last week, with the overall average returning at 299ppkg. Export and Supermarket spec lambs sold well and all mainly trading between 290ppkg and 310ppkg. Heavy weight lambs still strongly sought after with 50kg to 54kg lambs trading anywhere between £144 – £175. Lightweight lambs also sharper on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 260ppkg and 300ppkg depending on breed and meat cover. More spring lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.

A good entry of 37 forward this week with 19 of those making over £2000. Topping the day at £2798.65 was a Charolais bull weighing 1115kg selling for 251ppkg from EH & S Pugh, Blaencywarch. OTM cows sold to 350ppkg for a British Blue cow weighing 768kg totalling £2688 from DW & LE Morgan, Lower House. Next at £2562.56 was a Hereford x cow weighing 896kg selling for 286ppkg from FM & SJ Jones, Caebardd Farm. Younger cows sold to 327ppkg for a Limousin cow weighing 695kg making £2272.65 from HG & IW Rees, Faidre Fach. At £2118.10 was a Limousin x cow weighing 718kg selling for 295ppkg from DI Jones, Cwm.

Heifers under 48 months sold to 345ppkg for a Limousin x heifer weighing 581kg making £2004.45 from Davies & James, Gwenlas. Selling for £2301 was a Limousin x heifer weighing 767kg selling for 300ppkg from WG & DE Woosnam, Upper Gwestydd.

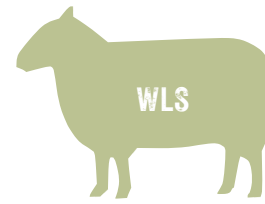
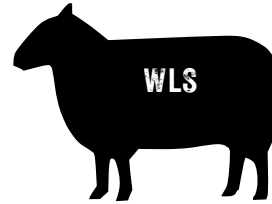
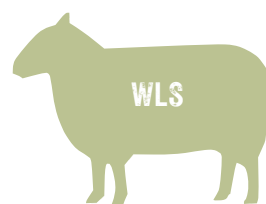
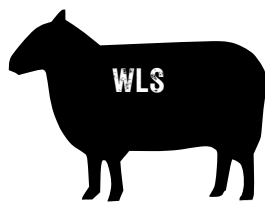
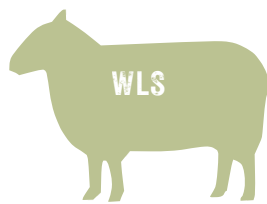
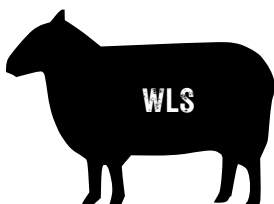
A larger entry of cull ewes forward this week with a total of 2,560 cull ewes penned meeting a slightly steadier trade on the week and returning an overall average of £80.52 per head for a yard consisting again of mainly hill ewes and leaner mule ewes with both large and heavy ewes very short on the ground. All crossbred ewes still from £120 - £175 per head if meat with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £125 - £155 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £90 - £120 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £55 - £88 per head. Strong hill ewes anywhere from £80 - £120 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £48 - £75 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £20 - £45, with only a handful of very small ewes below £20 per head. The ewes topped at £270 for a strong texel ewe presented by WRP & NW Jones, Pant. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade, with rams selling to the highs of £435 presented by JA Gwalchmai, Minffordd. Numerous crossbred rams £100 to £150 with hill rams anything from £70 to £120. Just a handful of 7 goats forward today seeing plenty of demand. Similar number of ewes will be wanted next week please. 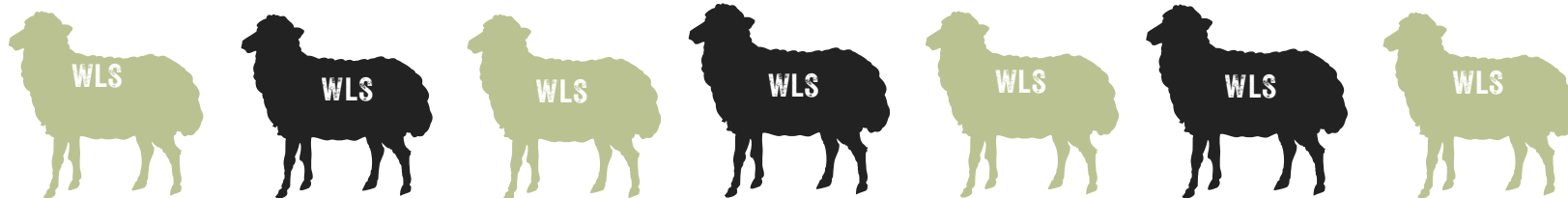

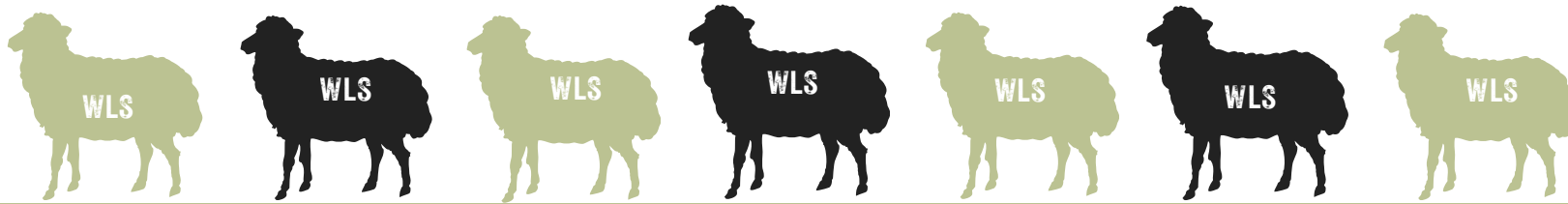
