
Strong numbers of prime lambs again this week with a total of 4,995 forward meeting a steadier trade, with the overall average returning at 311ppk. Export and Supermarket spec lambs sold well and all mainly trading between 295ppkg and 320ppkg. Best lambs trading 330ppkg to 350ppkg. Heavy weight lambs still strongly sought after with 50kg to 54kg lambs trading anywhere between £154 – £178. Lightweight lambs slight less on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 285ppkg and 310ppkg depending on breed and meat cover. Similar number of prime lambs required next week please!

OTM cows average 257.49ppkg to 329ppkg from JT Francis & Co, Pen Y Gaer.










An excellent entry of cull ewes forward this week with a total of 2,219 cull ewes penned meeting a similar trade on the week and returning an overall average of £116.50 per head for a varied entry of culls. All crossbred ewes trading from £140 – £185 per head if meat with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £135 – £170 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £100 – £125 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £70 – £95 per head. Strong hill ewes anywhere from £85 – £125 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £50 – £75 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £30 – £45.

The ewes topped at £280 for a strong texel x ewe presented by Gwawr Jones, Cefn Coch. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade, with rams selling to the highs of £225 presented by DES & ER Bickerton, Lloran Uchaf. Numerous crossbred rams £120 to £180 with hill rams anything from £80 to £130.

That said, all lambs still continue to look dear enough, particularly when set against the current fat lamb price, with competitive bidding seen throughout for the better-framed, well-bred sorts. Buyers remain selective on quality going into the New Year, but demand remains firm for the right type.




