A slight increase in numbers of prime lambs forward on the week with a total of 3,673 forward with trade back on the week, with the overall average returning at 298ppk. Export and Supermarket spec lambs sold well and all mainly trading between 290ppkg and 305ppkg. Heavy weight lambs still strongly sought after with 48kg to 54kg lambs trading anywhere between £145 - £175. Lightweight lambs very similar on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 265ppkg and 290ppkg.

More spring lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.







Another outstanding entry of cull ewes forward this week with a total of 3,132 cull ewes penned meeting a slightly lesser trade on the week and returning an overall average of £91.70 per head for a yard with very little strength and consisting of mainly hill ewes and leaner mule ewes. All crossbred ewes still from £130 - £185 per head if meat with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £125 - £160 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £100 - £125 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £60 - £95 per head. Strong hill ewes anywhere from £100 - £130 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £55 - £90 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £25 - £55, with only a handful of very small ewes below £25 per head. The ewes topped at £275 for some smart texel ewes presented by D Williams, Cefn Briw. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade, with rams selling to the highs of £227 presented by GI Francis & Co, The Bryn. Numerous crossbred rams £130 to £160 with hill rams anything from £80 to £120. Similar number of ewes will be wanted next week please.

The trade met with a touch more resistance, reflecting the recent drop in prime lamb prices. Shorter-keep lambs still found plenty of demand, with the best-bred sorts selling well throughout. Longer-term lambs proved harder to place, but still changing hands at levels that leave them looking fair value against the current prime trade.
