Lightweight lambs also sharper on the week and mainly trading anywhere between 290ppkg and 320ppkg depending on breed and meat cover.

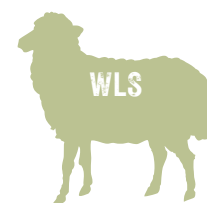
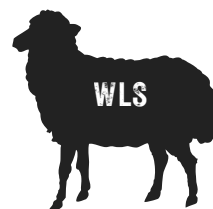
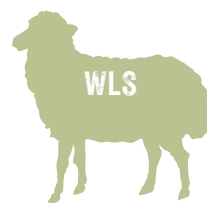
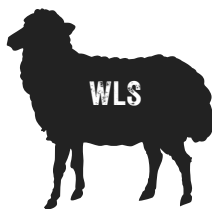
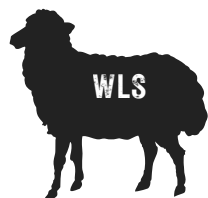
More prime lambs are now required on a weekly basis to meet buyers' demand.

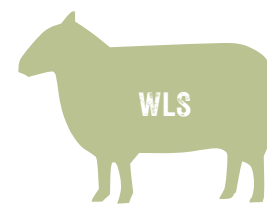
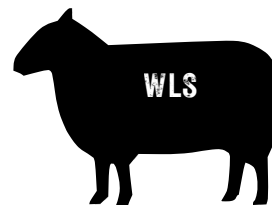
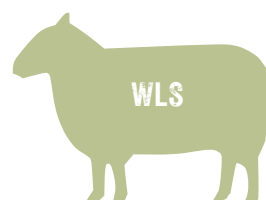
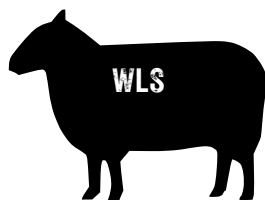
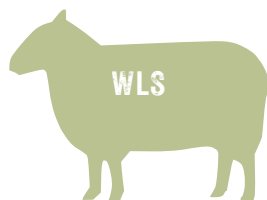
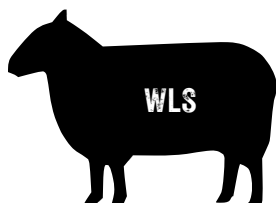
A similar entry of cull ewes forward this week with a total of 2,002 cull ewes penned meeting a far sharper trade on the week and returning an overall average of £93.73 per head for a yard consisting again of mainly hill ewes and leaner mule ewes with both large and heavy ewes very short on the ground. All crossbred ewes still from £135 - £185 per head if meat with quite a few very well-bred ewes and heavy ewes all over the £200 mark. Best Mules £130 - £160 per head with mediums Mules with meat mainly £90 - £120 per head. Leaner Mules anywhere from £55 - £88 per head. Strong hill ewes anywhere from £80 - £120 per head depending on size and cover, with medium Welsh all around that £48 - £75 per head and the smaller meated Welsh £20 - £45, with only a handful of very small ewes below £20 per head.

The ewes topped at £300 twice for some strong texel ewe presented by JH & CGO Davies, Trefaes Fawr and BH Jerman, Old Amblecote. Cull ram trade similar to last week's trade, with rams selling to the highs of £300 presented by HT Turner, Alltyffynnon for a pen of 4 Suffolk Rams. Numerous crossbred rams £120 to £180 with hill rams anything from £80 to £130.

A sharper trade again this week with lambs continuing to get dearer. Another competitive ringside of buyers ensured that all types sold to advantage, with particular strength seen on the well-bred farming lambs which proved the dearest on the day.

With confidence in the spring trade underpinning demand, the longer-term farming types were highly sought after and consistently achieved premiums over the short keep sorts. The recent late grass growth is also a factor, with buyers wanting the stronger framed lambs to take forward and utilise the fresh bite that has finally come in many areas. Well grown Texel and Continental cross lambs attracted the strongest bidding, pushing averages forward on the week. Native and hill lambs also sold well, reflecting the general lift in values. Overall, an animated trade throughout, with the outlook remaining firm as buyers continue to compete hard for numbers tightening towards the backend

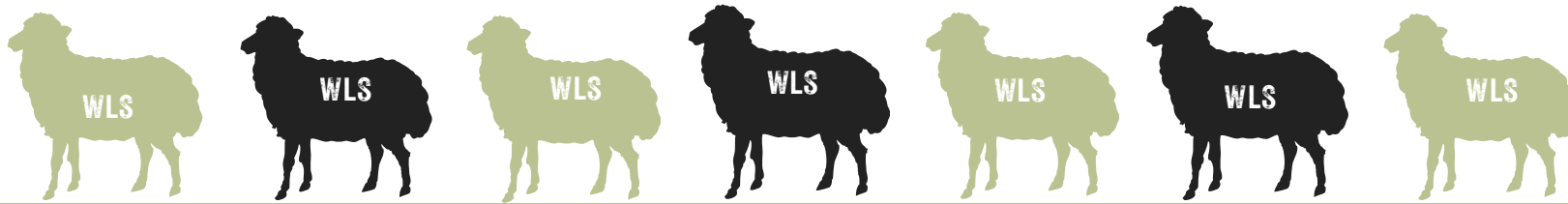
